Terms of Reference

1. Determine new policies or changes in policy relating to the development and delivery of services appropriate to this Committee;
2. Consider and, if appropriate, determine matters relating to Environment, Health & Safety and Equality & Diversity as relevant to the work of the Committee.
3. Consider all matters related to the delivery of services to the diverse communities of Merseyside, and the development, promotion and delivery of a coordinated strategy for developing and maintaining safer communities;

To include matters relating to:

Safer and Healthier Communities, Emergency response, Reduction in fires, deaths and injuries, Reduction in Road Traffic Collisions, Community Cohesion, and Youth engagement

4. Consider all matters relating to involvement with and delivery of Local Area Agreements.
5. Consider and make decisions in relation to the IRMP
6. Consider all matters related to the Civil Contingencies function of the Authority.
7. Consider the opportunities for and delivery of shared services in partnership with district councils and other agencies.
8. Consider all matters related to the Regional Management Board (RMB) and decisions taken by the RMB.
9. Consider all matters relating to involvement with and delivery of services delivered jointly by the NW Fire and Rescue Services.
10. Consider all matters related to the delivery of the Regional Control project including scrutiny of decisions taken in relation to the project by the project board.
11. Consider all matters relating to Fire Safety Legislation
12. To consider all matters relating to the development of the City Region/Mersey region agenda.

13. Consider any matters relating to the provision of services to the diverse communities of Merseyside.
14. Convene any Working Parties or Task Groups as may be appropriate to assist in fulfilling the duties of the Committee.
15. Consider and if appropriate, determine any other matters, which may be referred to the Committee by the Authority or the Executive Board.
16. Consider any matter which requires a decision by the Authority which cannot await its next meeting
