



Course Title Fire Marshal Training

Eligibility

The person or persons who have been nominated as Fire Marshal i.e. those personnel who have been given fire marshalling responsibilities in your organisation.

Course content

The course consists of theoretical and practical input for the staff who have been nominated as a Fire Marshal.

The course is designed specifically to promote fire safety within the workplace and to demonstrate to staff the causes of fire and to introduce safe working practices. The course includes extinguisher training both theory and a practical demonstration and students can use any of the commonly found extinguishers in the workplace on a real fire to gain experience.

Students will receive training and instruction in correct fire procedures and safe evacuations including generic fire marshal duties and responsibilities. On completion of the training the trainees will have sufficient knowledge and understanding to enable them to carry out all the duties and responsibilities of a Fire Marshal in the event of a fire.

To ensure staff have sufficient knowledge to enable them to act confidently and effectively in an emergency situation.

Outcome

Fire marshals to learn what to do and how to manage people to safety in an emergency or fire situation.
