

National Examination Board of Occupational Safety and Health (NEBOSH) Fire Safety and Risk Management

4 days

Course Content

This course is suitable for supervisors, managers and safety representatives and provides a broad understanding of health and safety issues equipping learners to contribute to more effective management of workplace risk.

The award comprises of two modules:

Unit FC1 FC2 Fire Safety

- Managing fire safety
- Principles of fire and explosion
- Causes and prevention of fire
- Fire protection in buildings
- Safety of people in the event of a fire

Unit FC2 Risk Management

- Fire risk assessment

The Fire Safety and Risk Management course may be completed as an additional unit to the NEBOSH National General Certificate and candidates will be given accreditation of prior learning for unit NGC1 to achieve the Certificate in Fire Safety & Risk Management.

This recognized and respected qualification covers fire causes, fire prevention and protection, by the time you sit the exam you will have successfully completed a fire risk assessment and thereby be better able to meet the legal requirements of the Regulatory Reform (Fire Safety) Order.



Duration

The course is delivered over four days, with an additional one day practical preparation.

How is the course assessed?

One day written examination (FC1) and a practical assessment (FC2) which must be completed within two weeks of the written exam.
